For the last thirty years Cracker Barrel Old Country Store, Inc. has been offering people on the highways of America an alternative to the fast food pit stop. 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what makes them different. However, when Cracker Barrel opened a new location in Bradenton, Florida, this customer service reputation was threatened.

The Problem

The new site in Bradenton was the most southern store at the time and the area experienced routine brownouts. At

certain times of the year brownouts could occur several times in one day. interrupting all POS terminals. According to Karen Ferrell, manager of support services for Cracker Barrel, at that point in time a store would run off a dedicated server. When the drop in voltage occurred the server went down bringing the entire system and the POS terminals down with it. Even though it would only take a few minutes to reboot and get the system running again, it could seem like forever to a guest waiting to pay a bill and leave. Once the system was back up, the interrupted sale would have to be started

again, prolonging the wait for the guest.
Concerned with these customer service issues,
Ferrell and her manager went straight to work to find a solution.

The Search

Several companies were contacted in order to address the brownout situation in Bradenton.

Ferrell remembers contacting many companies willing to sell their product to Cracker Barrel but she said, "ONEAC was willing to take a trip down to Bradenton with us . . . [to see] what equipment we needed, [and] to see

The Solution
